## **ALTERNATIVE ROUTES FOR HGVs OVER 7.5 TONS**

## FROM BATH DIRECTION (North - M5/M4) to Radstock/Midsomer Norton and the West

Take the A36

**To avoid A366** (Norton St Philip) when accessing Midsomer Norton or Radstock – Continue along the A36 to the first roundabout at Beckington,  $2^{nd}$  exit – short dual carriageway to roundabout, right hand lane, take  $3^{rd}$  exit onto A361 (Frome by-pass) down to next roundabout,  $1^{st}$  exit (A361) through to next roundabout (Frome Flyer on right)  $1^{st}$  exit, short distance to next roundabout,  $2^{nd}$  exit (A361) follow through to next roundabout,  $2^{nd}$  exit (A361) up the hill(known locally as the "ski slope") to roundabout,  $2^{nd}$  exit onto B3090 into Frome to roundabout (Sainsbury's on right)  $2^{nd}$  exit to next mini roundabout,  $1^{st}$  exit, follow through (Fire Station on right) take the next left A362 – signed Radstock follow route through to destinations of Midsomer Norton and Radstock, or alternatively use the A367 Wells Road from Bath to Radstock.

## FROM WARMINSTER DIRECTION (South) Inc. A303 to Radstock/Midsomer Norton and the West

A36 to Beckington, 1<sup>st</sup> roundabout, 1<sup>st</sup> exit onto A361 (Frome by-pass) down to next roundabout, 1<sup>st</sup> exit (A361) through to next roundabout (Frome Flyer on right) 1<sup>st</sup> exit, short distance to next roundabout, 2<sup>nd</sup> exit (A361) follow through to next roundabout, 2<sup>nd</sup> exit (A361) up the hill(known locally as the "ski slope") to roundabout, 2<sup>nd</sup> exit onto B3090 into Frome to roundabout (Sainsbury's on right) 2<sup>nd</sup> exit to next mini roundabout, 1<sup>st</sup> exit, follow through (Fire Station on right) take the next left A362 – signed Radstock follow route through to destinations of Midsomer Norton and Radstock.

## To avoid the B3110 from the South: (A36)

There is a 7.5 ton weight limit along the whole length of the B3110 from the A36 at Woolverton to the South, through Norton St Philip, Hinton Charterhouse, and Midford, leading into Bath. There is also a bridge height restriction of 12 feet at Midford. This route is often used as a short cut to avoid Bath to access Bristol. The correct HGV route is to follow the A36 to Bath and then the A4 to Bristol and visa-versa.

Drivers please remember that a sign with a **RED outer CIRCLE** means **Mandatory – OBEY!**
