

**SOMERSET COUNCIL
(NORTH STREET, NORTON ST PHILIP)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES)
ORDER 2024
(FILMING – MOTHER’S PRIDE)**

Notice is hereby given that Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as inserted by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation (Special Events) Act 1994, as amended, intends to make an Order, the effect of which will be to introduce the following temporary prohibition of vehicles as detailed in the Schedule below.

The Order will be made to facilitate filming and is in the interest of public safety.

The Order shall come into operation on the 16th day of September 2024. The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs and will remain in force only for as long as is necessary.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for emergency vehicles, any vehicles associated with the filming, any vehicle being used for the purpose of maintenance of the road and operations; maintenance of street furniture and infrastructure; supply of gas, water, or electricity; agriculture on any land adjacent and residents requiring access and egress when safe to do so.

Please note that should you require to view traffic restrictions which are more than two weeks ahead you will need to Register for free with One.Network.
