Ian Hasell, Chair of the Parish Council, welcomed everyone and gave a brief history of TAG.

Michael Walker invited everyone to introduce themselves and describe their interest in TAG's aims and where they lived, for context.

Concerns were mainly, in order:

Speeding, traffic volumes, aggressive drivers, illegal and inconsiderate parking, overweight HGVs, speeding (and silent) cyclists, ineffective traffic calming measures.

The TAG Terms of Reference were discussed and noted after much debate over the relationship of TAG to the PC. It was generally considered to be an advantage that TAG would be a less formal body than the Palaiet Hall and Churchmead committees. It was also agreed that an awareness of other communities' solutions to traffic issues should be encouraged.

David Lockley gave an introduction on Community SpeedWatch (CSW), Speed Indication Devices (SID) and Auto Speed Watch devices. The benefits and drawbacks were discussed at length but it was recognised that the benefits outweighed the disadvantages and that direct action by local people was essential to maintain support by the police and highways authorities.
