**Matters arising**

Safety of pedestrians on the high pavements at Church Street and North Street:  
For discussion at the next meeting. Meanwhile, TAG should ask PC for support to request Highways to maintain these historic pavements for safety while respecting their conservation *VF*

**A366**

An offer for a 50mph speed limit has been made by Highways but no details have yet been provided. IM suggested a meeting to discuss next steps: *IM, IB, VF, RE*

**Pedestrian safety – Anna N**

CN suggested, amongst other measures, finding a way to compare data on noise and pollution between NSP/FH and urban centres. CN and AN have requested the results of the pedestrian safety site visits in FH. *CM/RE*. AN and CN will continue to report progress and they were thanked for this.

**Bell Hill parking issues**

The Police have written to Somerset Highways to request that double yellow lines are considered to relieve the problem of inconsiderate pavement parking. TAG members considered alternative options:

- Double yellow lines (not supported by TAG or by previous village consultation)
- Collapsible bollards which residents can use – investigate practical and financial issues *VF*
- Residents' parking permits – investigate legal and practical issues *VF*

Further discussion is needed at the next meeting.

**CSW report – David L**

Thanks to DL for this month's updates. Also Ashley Reay's edict on SpeedWatch data inputs were agreed, ie we should check our details against the DVLA site; if a vehicle doesn't match the DVLA database do NOT send it in. The exception is a car colour that is similar, eg silver for grey.

**SID update**

No news – Dawn Denton and our Clerk chased Sara Davis again for the MoU we believe is necessary.

**Bollards and dropped kerb at the Fleur**

No reply yet to the email sent by the PC Clerk on 5 December asking for clarification of what is possible. She will chase.
